- Accessible parking is available in the rear of the building. This small parking lot is accessed via the alley between Oak Avenue and Ridge Avenue.

- Elevator access is available to all levels of the museum.
- Accessible restroom facilities are located on the lower level.

#### Thursday - 16 Oct Visits

**Elgin History Museum -** The back entrance to the building is mobility accessible. The Museum has an elevator that provides access to all three floors.

Sanfilippo Estate - Most of the Sanfilipo Residence is handicapped accessible. Upper and lower levels can be reached by our Victorian elevator. If you come in a wheelchair we have a wheelchair lift at the front entrance, and you'll be able to see over 90% of the tour (1 of the rooms has 3 steps up/down). If you can do the 3 steps into this room, you'll see it all. The Carousel Pavilion is fully accessible. All rooms have some seating available. When listening to our Wurlitzer Theater Organ, our Music Theater has a balcony with over 100 luxury theater seats (accessible by elevator). We judge the group's stamina and adjust accordingly.
